CALL FOR THE GRANT COMPETITION FOR THE PH. D. FELLOWSHIPS

The "Alma Mater" University Complex on Humanities at SU "St. Kliment Ohridski" announces a grant competition for **3 (three) fellowships** in the Humanities area for Ph.D. students who are citizens of either EU or third countries (Bulgaria excluded). The call targets applicants with basic education and the qualification of a "master" degree in the following academic fields: history, archaeology, ethnology, archival studies, political science, law, philosophy, administration and management, economy, journalism and public communications, philosophy, national security and other related interdisciplinary fields in the Humanities.

A priority in the research programme of the Complex are the topics of cultural and historic heritage, Bulgarian studies, the application of contemporary information technologies in education and research, regional studies and sustainable development.

The approved applicants will conclude a contract for the Ph. D. Fellowship with the Complex which will specify the obligation of the Complex to enroll the winners as unsupervised Ph.D. students on individual curriculum plans within 3 (three) months upon signing the contract and the obligation of the Ph.D. students to submit their theses for defense in a period of up to 36 months. The agreements stipulate also the conditions for the fellowship payment for a period not longer than 36 months as well as the other obligations and responsibilities of both parties.
